Instructions for Presenters

1. Talks should be prepared to last no more than eight minutes. Two additional minutes are allotted for Q&A and transition from one talk to the next. We are on a tight schedule so it is critical that everyone prepare his or her talk to fit in this timeframe.
2. We will collect the PowerPoint presentations and put them on a conference laptop (Windows). Please send your presentation to comparativecognitionsociety@gmail.com on or before **Monday October 31**. If you are using video or audio files as part of your presentation, those likely have to be sent separately from the ppt/pptx files. (It is a good idea to test presentations with video or audio components on a computer other than the one on which it was prepared to be sure all necessary files are included in what you send us.) Be sure to bring a backup copy of your presentation on a USB storage device, CD, or on your own laptop.
3. Our meeting will be held in Room "Metropolitan B" of the Sheraton Seattle Hotel and begins at 8:15 on Thursday Nov 3. We expect to have coffee service set up before the meeting begins.
